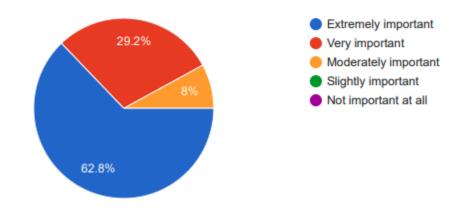

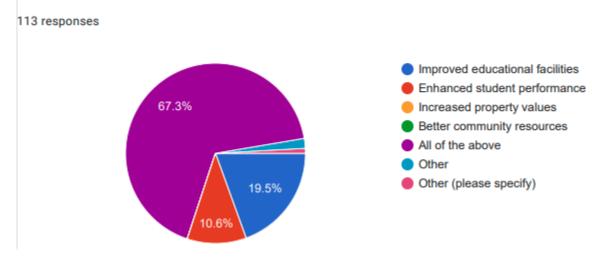
IMPORTANCE & BENEFITS OF THIS BOND AS PER COMMUNITY SURVEY

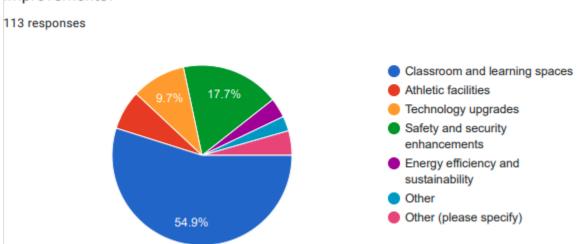
What do you believe are the potential benefits of passing a school capital referendum?



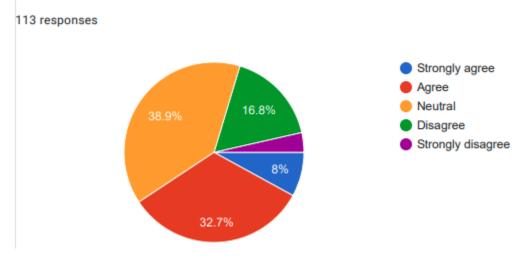


PRIORITIES AND FACILITIES OF THIS BOND AS PER COMMUNITY SURVEY

Do you feel that the current school facilities are adequate for student needs?

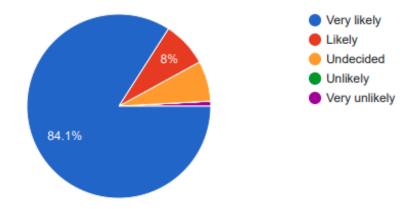

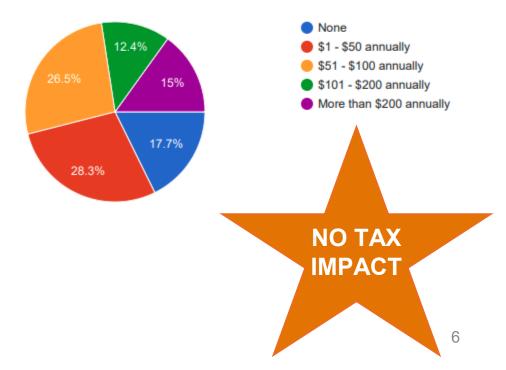
How likely are you to support a school capital referendum if there were no tax impact?

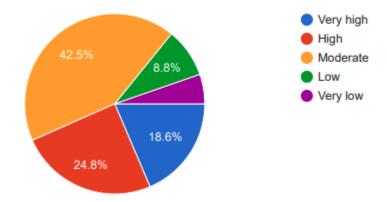




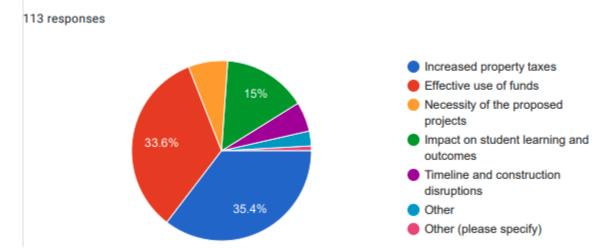
LEVELS OF TRUST AND CONCERNS

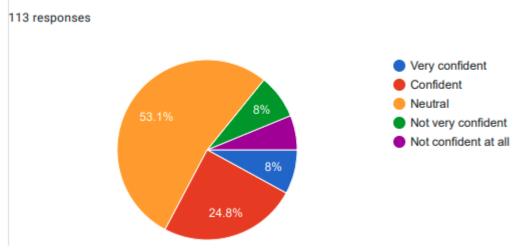






LEVELS OF CONFIDENCE
